The General Assembly has also elected the following members to serve on the Election Committee: Argyro Andriopoulos, Kiki Gargas and Kathy Lakkas.



Following the service at church, during a reception in our community center, students from our Greek School sang three great songs dedicated to the

What a glorious day!










