

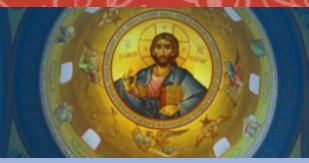

The General Assembly has also elected the following members to serve on the Election Committee: Argyro Andriopoulos, Kiki Gargas and Kathy Lakkas.

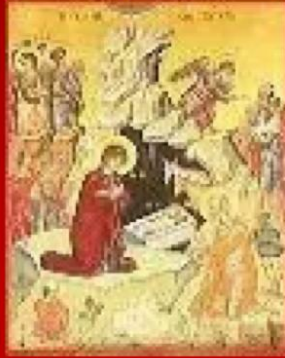

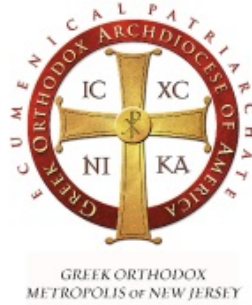
